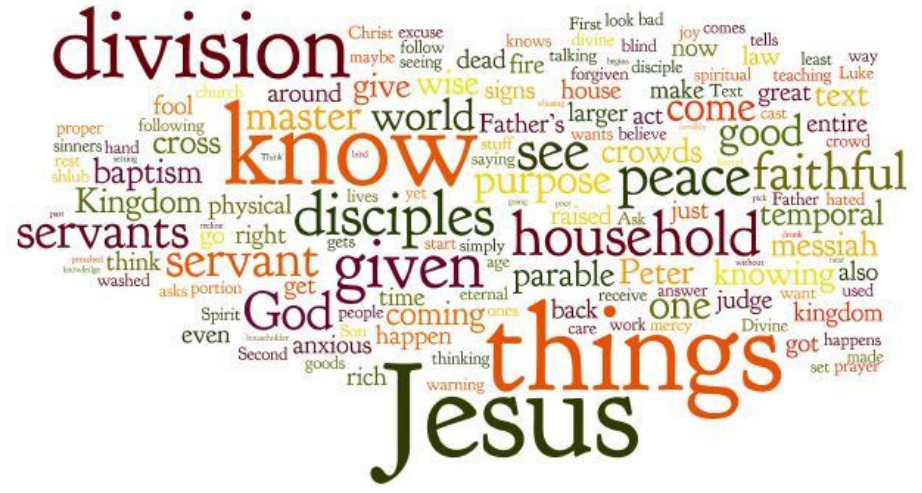

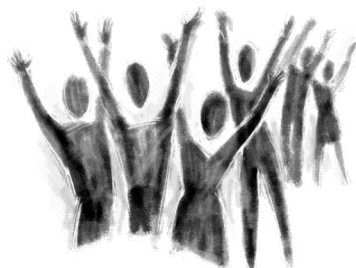

1st Reading Isaiah 5: 1-7 Psalm 80: 1-2, 8-19

2nd Reading Hebrews 11: 29 - 12: 2 Gospel Luke 12: 49-59

Sentence:

'Is not my word like fire,' says the Lord, 'and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?'
Jeremiah 23.29

Collect:

Hear, O Shepherd of Israel, you that led Joseph like a flock:
you that are enthroned upon the cherubim, shine out in glory;

**Before Ephraim, Benjamin and Manasseh:

You brought a vine out of Egypt: you drove out the nations, and planted it in.
