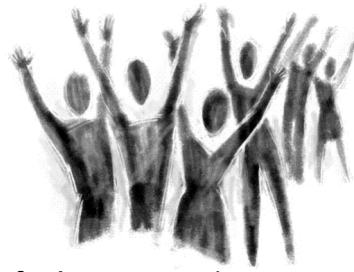

1st Reading Isaiah 11: 1-10 **Psalm** 72: 1-7, 18-21
2nd Reading Romans 15: 4-13 **Gospel** Matthew 3: 1-12

Sentence:

The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news. *Mark 1. 15*

Collect:
