I have asked the architect to give us a "back of the envelope cost" for the different components (underground car park, units, conference room, office, residence) of the project. When this is received it will be circulated.

The project is at the very early concept stage. We have to work out what the costs are for different configurations and what we can do in terms of finance.

You can be assured that there will be lots of consultation. We will call the parish meeting when we arrive at appropriate decision points.
